Dear Hillsdale Families,

2020 is the most extraordinary year any of us has ever faced in the education world. We responded in March with a great deal of sweat and care and learned a lot about supporting our students in this unique environment--our school is rooted in the importance of relationships and relationships mean people and staff. Our district is generous in supporting our staffing needs, but we simply do not have enough allocated resources. Last year, we added staff to support our growing enrollment and we will see our student population grow once more this year. And that is where the Foundation comes in to fill this funding shortfall.

This year marks our 18th anniversary since HHS redefined the comprehensive high school experience by putting the student's needs at the center of a nationally recognized **Small Learning Community (SLC)** model. Hillsdale became a Stanford Partnership school and in September 2016 was named a "School of Opportunity" by the National Education Policy Center at the University of Colorado, the <u>first</u> school in California to earn the gold level.

Hillsdale combines the best of small schools — personalized learning, extended relationships, grade-level advisory — with the best of big schools — athletics, clubs, and electives. The result is a place that is more than a school; it is a home for students and staff, a place where your student will be known. Students benefit from:

- Reduced class sizes in 9th and 10th grade
- Core teachers and advisor assigned for two consecutive years
- Personalized instruction with teacher/advisor student mentoring
- Rigorous and integrated curriculum including comprehensive portfolio projects

Hillsdale High School Athletic Boosters

Hillsdale High School provides students with a wide variety of athletic opportunities and we invite you to join the Boosters in support of these programs. Our mission is to enable students to enhance their academic experience by participating in a variety of sports,



enriching their time in high school, and teaching them life lessons through athletics. Through participation donations and other fundraising, we raise and spend more than \$120,000 annually to supplement the athletic department budget and provide uniforms, equipment, Freshman sports, assistant coaching stipends and other critical program needs that are not covered by district funding.

The Participation Donation has remained at \$75 per athlete per sport for several years, even while expenses have increased – particularly the costs of maintaining and building a top-notch coaching staff. In fact, last year (2019-2020) the Boosters funded \$132 per athlete with additional funds raised via other fundraising activities. With costs rising faster than revenue growth, the Boosters will be increasing the annual donation request in the future, but with our community in distress, businesses struggling and family incomes in doubt, we are maintaining the request at \$75 this scholastic year. We also anticipate that alternative funding sources will be challenged this year, adding up to a difficult year. If you can contribute more than \$75 per athlete per sport, we greatly appreciate it, as doing so will help us meet the needs of our thriving athletic program.

The Athletic Boosters meet on the first Monday of every month at 7:00 pm in Room 210 at HHS. You are invited to attend our meetings, show your support, meet other parents and the coaches and provide input on where to spend our donated funds.

As a parent of a Hillsdale Athlete, you are automatically a member of the Boosters. **Please make a \$75** participation donation for each sport your student plays. The participation donation is per athlete, per sport.
