Dear Hillsdale Families,

Hillsdale started to feel like it should again during the second semester last year--games, plays, projects, clubs, students on campus and being together. Hillsdale High School is rooted in relationships and relationships mean students and staff together--we are so excited to build on last year and create unforgettable experiences for our whole community in 2022-23. We believe our staff is the best anywhere and, while our district is generous in supporting our school, we simply do not have enough allocated resources to meet all of our needs. And that is where the Foundation comes in to fill this funding shortfall.

This year marks our 21st anniversary since HHS redefined the comprehensive high school experience by putting the student's needs at the center of a nationally recognized Small Learning Community (SLC) model. Hillsdale became a Stanford Partnership school and in September 2016 was named a "School of Opportunity" by the National Education Policy Center at the University of Colorado, the first school in California to earn the gold level.

Hillsdale combines the best of small schools — personalized learning, extended relationships, grade-level advisory — with the best of big schools — athletics, clubs, and electives. The result is a place that is more than a school; it is a home for students and staff, a place where your student will be known. Students benefit from:

- Reduced class sizes in 9th and 10th grade
- Core teachers and advisor assigned for two consecutive years
- Personalized instruction with teacher/advisor student mentoring
- Rigorous and integrated curriculum including comprehensive portfolio projects

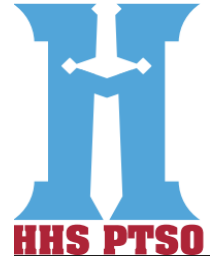

Hillsdale High School Athletic Boosters



Hillsdale High School provides students with a wide variety of athletic opportunities and we invite you to join the Boosters in support of these programs. Our mission is to enable students to enhance their academic experience by participating in a variety of sports, enriching their time in high school, and teaching them life lessons through athletics. Through participation donations and other fundraising, we raise and spend more than \$120,000 annually to supplement the athletic department budget and provide uniforms, equipment, Freshman sports, assistant coaching stipends and other critical program needs that are not covered by district funding.

The suggested participation donation remained the same for many years, even while expenses increased – particularly the costs of maintaining and building a top-notch coaching staff. We look forward to a full, competitive year in 2022-2023, but we have some ground to make up as the “pandemic years” saw a dip in revenues, while expenses remained flat. This year the suggested participation fee increases to \$85 per athlete per sport. If you can contribute more than \$85 per athlete per sport, we greatly appreciate it, as doing so will help us meet the needs of our thriving athletic program.

As a parent of a Hillsdale Athlete, you are automatically a member of the Boosters. **Please make a \$85 participation donation for each sport your student plays. The participation donation is per athlete, per sport.**

The Athletic Boosters also provide Family Entrance Passes, admitting 2 adults and 2 non high school children into all regular season football and basketball games within the District. Information on purchasing Family Entrance Passes will be circulated when the sports year calendar is finalized.

Additionally, the boosters plan to offer discounted annual subscription packages to the NFHS Network, our new system that broadcasts all games / events at the football field and main gym. Details to follow.

The Athletic Boosters meet on the first Monday of every month (except school holidays) at 7:00 pm in Room 210 at HHS as well as via a Zoom video conference. You are invited to attend our meetings, show your support, meet other parents and the coaches and provide input on where to spend our funds.
