A Note from the Principal

Jeff Gilbert, Lead Principal

On February 27, Hillsdale High School opened the doors of our new academic wing and celebrated the (nearing) completion of the facility which is dedicated to science, world language and child development. A few glitches in the final stages of construction will delay our use of the rooms but the science labs are wonderful and will serve our students well for years to come. The need for the new building is increasingly clear as we are in the process of enrolling our largest 9th grade class in decades. We are estimating a Freshman class of approximately 450 students and, therefore, a fourth Smaller Learning Community in 2017-18.

We are continuing to grow our Computer Science program at HHS! We currently have 2 sections of Computer Science Principles and 1 section of AP Computer Science A. Our two Hillsdale CS teachers are being supported by the amazing work of the TEALS volunteers who are in the classroom helping students and teachers on a regular basis.

Bohannon Foundation Provides \$7,500 Challenge Match

The Bohannon Foundation has generously provided a challenge match of \$7,500 towards the purchase of a \$15K computer cart. Advanced science classes have grown dramatically at Hillsdale over the past decade, with Advanced Placement courses increasing from six to ten sections. At the same time, we have been a leader in ensuring rigorous science education for all students, requiring that all students take Biology as 9th graders and Chemistry as 10th graders, while cutting D and F rates by more than half in the past five years. The opening of our new science wing opens exciting possibilities for us to provide all students with a dynamic science education that focuses on critical thinking rather than rote learning. To that end, we have invested in Proeware and computers for our Physics program and have begun providing Chemistry and Biology classes with technology that will allow for more engaging projects in those classes. We need to purchase a computer cart for both Biology and Chemistry, to go into the new lab spaces that will open in the fall. The acquisition of these carts will provide critical resources to what is becoming a model science program on the Peninsula.

All Hillsdale students complete a Senior Defense, modeled on a doctoral dissertation, which draws on "portfolio projects" completed in every course and at every level. More and more, students are choosing to defend in science, and the projects that

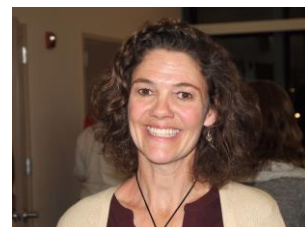
Rachel Barrantes on the Value of Computer Carts. . .

In addition to computer carts, a large percentage of the money raised for the Foundation pays for planning time and four sections of classes for Hillsdale teachers, making the SLC model possible. Hillsdale's small advisory model has allowed our teams to build relationships with students and get to know them in a way that supports students, builds community, and allows all of us to find success. In the next four years, Hillsdale is slated to see increased enrollment and the costs of growing and then maintaining our SLCs will only go up, especially in the next two years of implementation. We know that families have very different resources to contribute but our goal is to have 100% participation, so please donate at whatever level you can.
